Health and Safety

- The back deck by the kitchen still needs water blasting. Ian to try and do it prior to Christmas
- Fire alarm not working. Bruce following up with our electrical contractor.
- The ladder that can be used by anyone accidentally falling into the water from the jetty or a nearby boat requires replacement. Bruce to try and source a suitable replacement that has a fold-up lower section such that it won't be damaged during low tides.
- Mark pointed out a Health and Safety issue with the sea wall in front of the Youth Sailing shed.
 Wave motion has caused erosion behind the concrete wall making it very difficult to climb up. A temporary fix is to add some builders mix with cement in the gaps behind the wall. Smoothing out the bank above the wall will also help. Barry has offered the cement.

Financial Report

- Accounts are now in a much better position back in the black
- 37 membership invoices still outstanding
- Opening night for Rata's kitchen when very well, much more manageable on Saturday and Sunday.
- Ongoing Power account seams excessive high. Stephen suggested that we arrange a
 Refrigeration engineer to check the main fridges. Stephen to check current draws on existing
 equipment
- Ongoing Still looking for a new auditor

Sub Committee Reports

Social & Events

- Very busy month. 2 major events plus a private function
- Opening night for Rata's Kitchen as a success around 120 people present
- Rata would like to replace our Vertical Fridge with her own. Consider selling our very old fridge.
- Approval given to proceed with the replacement of several kitchen window stays.
- All excess cooking now oil removed. This task will be undertaken by Rata's Kitchen's in future.
- Consider adding some screening to hide the external kitchen entrance area.
- John, the sign man, has offered to donate some signage for the club. Helen will follow-up

Building & Maintenance

- Toilet door external lock code changed. Still some ongoing issues with damage to the toilets. We
 will add signage to the outside of the building informing visitors that we have security camera's in
 operation. Need to follow-up with viewing security camera footage directly after any damage is
 found.
- Scotty has completed an inventory of what's required to fix building issues identified by a recent council inspection. Work will be undertaken early next year and before another sizable function is held in the club rooms.
- Ongoing Mast crane. Brett Avery and Steve Hardcastle looking at whether it's practical to reinstate. Concerns were raised over the Health and Safety aspect of operating this device if it is reinstated.
- **Ongoing** Discussions with DOC regarding renewal of lease for areas of the club that are on their land is ongoing. The old lease expired in 2012.. Aim to get this resoled first ¼ next year. Also renewing the license to use the grassed area for Tall Ships Done **Bruce**.
- Ongoing Quote received for stage power points. Price higher than expected so Scotty will arrange for a 2nd quote.
- On hold due to lack of funds Looking into options for adding a cover on the outdoor seated area. Bruce working with Scotty on a concept. Need to check if this can be funded from the building fund.
- Ongoing Roof still leaking above the bar Bruce has contacted Phil and it's on his to do list.

- **Motion** that Stephen joins the Kitchen Bar and Cleaning sub-committee and that this sub-committee is responsible for staff employment. Moved Bruce, 2nd Mark, Carried.
- Stephen & Helen have had a meeting with Maddy has discussed improvements to the bar area. The committee would like to proceed with the purchase new wine glasses Stephen will get prices. A number of other minor improvements were also discussed.
- The sub-committee meetings with bar staff to be ongoing once per month.
- The committee agreed to provide a club shirt for the bar staff
- Next working bee task, re-paint table stands.
- The club has had an applicant for the cleaning role. Need to arrange an offer and an employment contract.
- Rata's Kitchen's contract signed with only minor changes.
- Club's food stocks sitting at the bottom of the freezer, try and use as much as we can at Tall Ships.
- Request that we track financially how the new kitchen arrangement is working to aid with our decision-making process at the time of Rata's contract review.

Sailing

- There were no Opua boats at last Sunday's Interclub for the Fisher & Paykel Trophy.
- Ongoing Update. RBC's two Event applications for running Yacht racing in the BOI Marine
 Mammal Sanctuary (general racing and Tall Ships) have been submitted to Doc for approval. Our
 applications include an addendum to our Sailing Instructions that help to notify sailors of the
 Sanctuary rules and how they should handle a possible encounter with any Marine Mammals while
 racing within the Sanctuary.

Tall Ships

• Arrange an all-up (shore and on the water teams) meeting in early December. This meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, December 13th at the RBC rooms.

Youth Sailing

- The Youth sailing team together with some of the trainee's put together a great float for the recent Russell Christmas parade.
- There are around 8 kids taking part in the summer training program
- Mark pointed out a Health and Safety issue with the sea wall in front of the Youth Sailing shed.
 Wave motion has caused erosion behind the concrete wall making it very difficult to climb up. A
 temporary fix is to add some builders mix with cement in the gaps behind the wall. Smoothing out
 the bank above the wall will also help. Barry has offered the cement. (this item has also been
 captured in the Health and Safety section of these minutes)
- Bruce gave an update on progress with the new Youth Sailing shed. A concept plan has been
 created by Bruce. Detailed plans and a resource consent will be required before this project can
 proceed. Bruce has already consulted with DOC, the regional council and local Maori where their
 feedback has been very positive.

- We need to name boat one. Ideas on how we can do this were discussed
- Stephen has requested a review whether we should continue with launching the 2nd boat as it requires extensive work to get it ready for racing. This review will take place early next year.
